THE SHORES CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC. SWIMMING POOL RULES

- 1.) Pool Hours are from 8:00 AM to 10:00 PM. Many owners have windows open and sound carries from the pool and echoes between the buildings when in the courtyard area. Please minimize the volume of voices (especially when we have children visiting) and limit activity in the courtyard, using the beach for games etc.
- 2.) No children under the age of 12 are allowed in the pool area or pool without an adult present.
- 3.) No one is allowed to enter the pool in diapers or if not toilet trained. Infants wearing "Huggies Little Swimmers" may use the pool. If an incident occurs, it must be reported to the Manager who in turn is required by the Health Department to close the pool for 24 hours and super shock the pool with a heavy dose of chlorine.
- 4.) Please do not move pool furniture to the beach or the lawn and feet should not be rested on tables.
- 5.) Use a towel between you and the furniture to protect it from sun lotions and oil as they can stain and harm the furniture.
- 6.) Please respect the use of the pool area by all owners and remove all personal items when leaving the pool area, even if for a short duration.
- 7.) If you raise the umbrellas, lower them before leaving the pool area.
- 8.) No glass containers are permitted in the pool/beach area. Broken glass is dangerous to individuals and if any glass has entered the pool, it will need to be drained.
- 9.) If you have been using the tables, please clean up and wipe them off before you leave. Replace chairs to their original positions.
- 10.) Smoking is prohibited in the pool area and common areas of The Shores.
- 11.) When coming from the beach, please rinse shoes and other items to keep sand out of pool and other areas.
- 12.) Proper attire and foot wear are required in the building. Please wear a coverup and appropriate foot wear to and from the pool and beach and dry thoroughly before entering the building as wet floors could be dangerous.
- 13.) All cell phones need to be silence in pool and deck areas. If calls are received or made, please remove yourself from the pool and deck area.
